School report: Strong passes in all his subjects and best subjects are Maths and Science. Received a certificate for best attendance for the year.

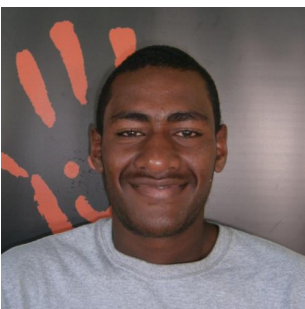
Mereseini
